Thank you for supporting us as we reach out with hope and love in the name of Jesus Christ!

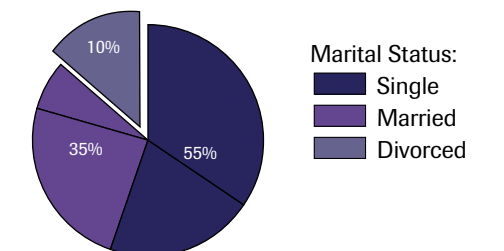
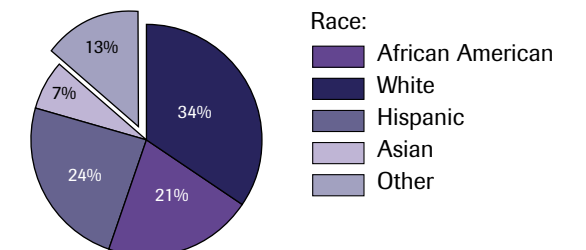
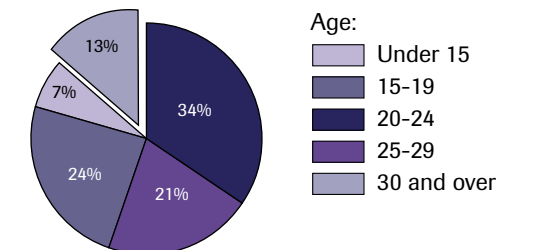

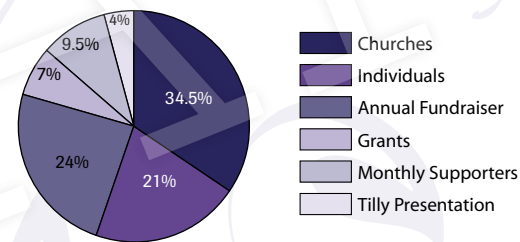
